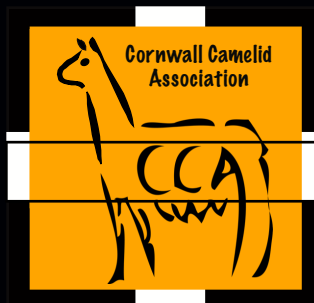

The Judging Process

The judge is looking for alpacas who are healthy and producing exceptional fleece quality.



Conformation counts for 40% of the assessment

This is the physical characteristics of the alpaca and the judge is looking for characteristics such as a correctly proportioned frame, straight top line, free movement, teeth aligned with the upper dental pad & correct genitalia.

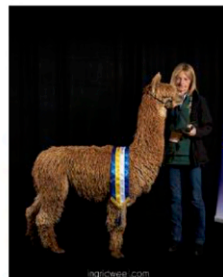
Fleece quality counts for 60%

Ultimately, alpacas are kept for their fleece. To score top marks the fleece should be fine, consistent and dense across the maximum possible area of the body with good length. It should also have uniform colour and be bright – in Suri the judge is particularly looking for lustre.

Our Judge: Julia Corrigan-Stuart, CS Alpacas

Certified as a BAS Judge: September 2019

I became involved with alpacas in 2008, when we purchased a property that had 12 acres of land that needed grazing. I began with 3 pregnant female huacayas, which has now increased to circa 120 alpacas with nearly half the herd being huacayas and the other half being suris.



I had a thirst for more knowledge about these majestic animals and attended all the BAS courses going, as well as handling on judges' courses etc. I then decided to go down the judging route. At the same time I became heavily involved with the BAS National Fleece Show and also became the Fleece Show Organiser and the Chief Steward for the HoEAG Group, which I still do to date.

In the past 15 years, I have visited Peru to see the alpacas and the processing mills, as well as attending the Annual Suri Symposium in the USA. I have travelled all over the UK judging Alpaca fleece and halter shows, as well as attending calibration clinics and workshops with British and International Judges alike.

My aim is to offer guidance and education to exhibitors and the public when judging Shows. I would like my reputation as a judge to be known for being fair, impartial and objective, always judging to the set BAS judging criteria.

The Halter Show

There are two types of shows in alpaca 'world' – Halter Shows and Fleece Shows.

- In a **Halter Show**, the competing alpacas are brought into the ring (wearing a halter) and the judge assesses both their conformation and fleece – this is what you will see today
 - In a **Fleece Show**, the shorn fleece from the alpaca is entered and assessed
- The Halter Show has classes for alpacas which are split between the type of alpaca, their sex, age and colour.

Types of alpaca

There are two types of alpaca - **Huacaya** (the fluffy looking ones) and **Suri** (with the longer dreadlock style fleece).

There are many more Huacaya in the world than Suri - the Suri population is estimated to be around 10%, so there are almost always more Huacaya in the competition

They compete in separate classes throughout and there will be a Supreme Champion of each type.

Colours

There are officially 22 different colours of alpaca – but in a show these are condensed into 6 colour groups: Black, Grey, Brown, Fawn, Light & White.

There are separate classes for Appaloosa alpacas (spotty ones) and Multi or Fancy alpacas (those with different blocks of colour)

Males & Females

Within each colour category, Males & Females are judged in separate classes all the way until the final Supreme Line up (see below)

Age

Finally, alpacas of the same colour and sex are split into classes by 4 age groups – junior (<1yr), intermediate (1-2yrs), adult (2-4yrs) and seniors (>4yrs).

Awards

Rosettes will be awarded to those from **1st to 6th place** in each class


A male and female **Colour Champion** and **Reserve Colour Champion** will be awarded after judging the 1st and 2nd placed alpacas in each class against those in the other age groups of the same colour and sex.

At the end of the Show, the Male and Female Colour Champions will all line up together in the Supreme Champion line up. There will be separate Supreme line ups for Huacaya and Suri and the judge will award the **Supreme Huacaya** and **Supreme Suri** of the show.

Alpaca Fleece Facts

If you haven't had the chance to feel alpaca fleece before, please do make sure to do so today.



Huacaya fleece

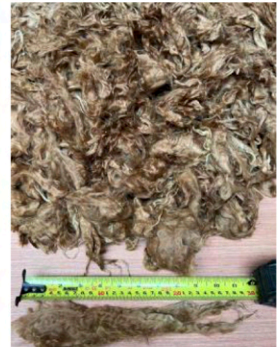
The Incas called alpaca the 'fibre of the Gods' and it was reserved to make clothing for royalty. It is beautifully soft and strong and makes garments that are warm but light to wear.

Huacaya fleece is very light and airy and great for knitwear.

Suri is typically longer and smoother, like silk and provides a lovely drape to fabric - great for weaving.

Summary of alpaca fleece characteristics

- ★ **Soft** – it has a different, smoother scale structure than wool so is not 'prickly'
- ★ **Bright & lustrous** – the smoother scales also give alpaca fleece a natural sheen
- ★ **Warm** – estimated to be 3x warmer than wool
- ★ **Strong & durable** – alpaca fibres have more tensile strength than wool fibres
- ★ **Hypoallergenic** – as it does not contain lanolin
- ★ **Water Resistant** – it does not retain water so is a great insulator, even when wet
- ★ **Fire Resistant** – with a lower 'heat release' rate compared to other wools
- ★ Huacaya is particularly suited to **knitting**
- ★ Suri is a better fit for **woven goods**

Alpaca Fun Facts

In addition to their amazing fleece, alpacas are lovely animals to be around as all the owners here will tell you

They are calming, gentle and inquisitive and love to come and investigate what you are up to and hang around with you. Some people do yoga in the field with alpacas as they are so 'zen'!

They generally don't like to be caught though so if you try to cuddle or stroke them they tend to pull away.

Here are some fun facts

- Alpacas are really old – they were domesticated over 6000 years ago by the ancient Incans of Peru for their fibre – they valued alpaca fibre more than Gold!
- Most alpacas live to between 15 and 20 years old
- Alpacas generally weight between 50 and 90kg – some are over 100kg
- Alpacas are pregnant for about 11.5 months. They usually only have one baby called a 'cria' and generally give birth during the daytime
- Alpacas are the most environmentally friendly of agricultural grazing animals – they live lightly on the earth because they have soft, padded feet
- Alpacas mainly eat grass and hay but we usually also give them some mineral supplements as hard pellets to keep them healthy
- Lots of people confuse alpacas with llamas! They are related to each other as part of the Camelid family but they are also quite different.
 - Llamas are good at carrying things – they are taller than alpacas and have 'bendy' shaped ears that look a bit like bananas! (remember: 'llama banana' 😊)
 - Alpacas are smaller and are bred for their fleece
